After Easter the students will embark on a British Science Association Bronze Crest Award. This is a nationally recognised Award for young people between the ages of 11-19. In their Science lessons students will undertake a piece of original research, planning, carrying out and evaluating their work. This can be done individually or in small groups, and students will have a choice about the topic they study.
