Identification of students:

Criteria: *(including parent, student nominations, teacher nominations and a variety of data)*

Students are selected if they have been identified by their Middle School teacher as reaching a very high National Curriculum level (year 9) or by their class teacher (years 10 & 11). Any bilingual language speakers or those working at level 7 or above at KS3 or A/A* level at KS4 are also included.

Review:

The Gifted and Talented list is reviewed after each progress check and additions can be made to the list on the recommendation of the subject teacher.

Notification:

Students and parents are informed at the start of the academic year and during the course, if their work is considered to be at the appropriate level. 'No Limits' students are discussed at parents' evening.

Curriculum opportunities with 'No Limits' :

All KS5 MFL students have access to reference resources such as magazines, dictionaries and grammar guides in the languages department which they can use to develop their examination or class work.

We hope to offer further opportunities in the future by increasing the number of languages on offer at HUS.

At all key stages, we identify a number of useful websites that can be used for curriculum reinforcement work.

Enrichment opportunities with 'No Limits':

The MFL department offers a number of trips abroad which can involve students at all key stages.

All students have the possibility of having their work displayed in the department where it can be viewed by parents and visitors.

For the last two years, a foreign film club for KS4 AND KS5 students has been run after school.
