**Identification of students:**

**Criteria:** *(including parent, student nominations, teacher nominations and a variety of data)*

Students are selected on the basis of promise demonstrated in lessons and measured improvement throughout the academic year. All students working at or above grades A / A\* at GCSE, 'AS' or 'A2' level are considered by the department to be our 'No Limits' students. Parents and students can also nominate a student for consideration. Extension activities are also extended to students who demonstrate verbal reasoning skills and sound knowledge during theoretical debate but are unable to repeat this on paper.

**Review:**

'No limits' students are reviewed after each half-termly progress check and students who are considered to be developing their ability at this level are included on our lists.

**Notification:**

We inform students and parents at the beginning of the academic year if we consider a student to be working at the appropriate level. This is always discussed with students and their parents at parents' evenings.

**Curriculum opportunities with 'No Limits' :**

'No limits' students can further extend their thinking skills by joining the lunch time Theoretical Thinking Club which is design to enhance philosophical and therefore theoretical understanding for the gifted and talented. This will enable students to further develop skills.

**Enrichment opportunities with 'No Limits':**

The Sociology department aims to extend all students through enrichment opportunities for example, a comparative study of middle class and working class Britain.
